

## DAY OF PRESENTATION CHECKLIST



1.	Room set up and ready one hour before presentation start time (Section 1-a: Itinerary Details, p. 4; Section 2: The Room, p. 7; Materials for the Teacher: Room Setup Diagram, p. 17).
2.	Name Tags safety-pinned on each student in light-colored red, white, and blue card stock according to teams (Section 3-b: Teams and Name Tags, p. 8; Materials for the Teacher: Name Tag Instructions, p. 16).
3.	Hard writing surface for each student (Section 5-a: Liberty Bell Game Sheets, p. 11).
4.	Pencil for each student; additional pencils for breakage (Section 5-a: Liberty Bell Game Sheets, p. 11).
5.	Copies of <i>Liberty Bell Game Sheet</i> (one for each student) to hand to your presenter upon arrival (Section 5-a: Liberty Bell Game Sheets, p. 11; Materials for Duplication, p. 33).
6.	Score Sheet, pencil/pen, and parent/adult scorekeeper chosen to keep score (Materials for the Teacher: Score Sheet, p. 18; and Section 1-d: Day of Presentation, p. 6).
7.	Card Assignment List, all Duplicate Cards and Battle Scenes (Materials for the Teacher, p. 15, 20–30).
8.	Students arrive with <i>Expert Word, Character, and American Experiment Cards</i> , even if memorized. Re-assign cards of absent students to students on their team (Section 4: The Cards, p. 9; Materials for Distribution, p. 36–43).
9.	Battle Scenes: teams ready with any necessary props, set pieces and Battle Scene scripts (Sections 5-b: Battles of the American Revolution, p. 11, and Materials for Distribution, p. 44–46).
10.	Arrive to presentation room a few minutes before scheduled start time with students in three teams and <i>Team Generals (Leaders)</i> at the front. Your presenter will greet you and your students outside the room (Section 1-d: Day of Presentation, p. 6).
