



How to Prepare for the virtual Walk Through the American Revolution presentation

Preparation for your virtual Walk Through presentation will remain mostly the same as preparation for an in-person Walk Through. Instructions specific to a virtual presentation are provided in notations within each section of the Teacher Preparation Guide where an adjustment for virtual has been made. Reading over the checklists at the front of the guide is always a good place to start your preparation.

### WHAT TO PRINT OUT FROM THE TEACHER GUIDE...

We do not suggest printing out the entire Teacher Preparation Guide.

1. Print out the following pages from the Teacher Preparation Guide for teacher use:

- **Card Assignment List** (needed for assigning parts) – p. 18

Note: students will be placed in 3 teams by the colors: **RED, WHITE, BLUE**  
Character, Expert Word, and American Experiment cards are already pre-designated to each of the three teams.

- **Score Sheet** (for keeping score during the presentation) - p. 21

2. Print out Character, Expert Word, American Experiment cards and Liberty Bell Game sheet to be distributed to individual students.

All items to be distributed can be found in the Teacher Preparation guide on the following pages..

Note: There is no longer a back side to the American Experiment cards. The entire reading “first part” and “second part” are both on the front side.

- **Liberty Bell Game Sheet** – to be copied and distributed one to each student. (p. 40)
- **Star Spangled Banner** – This will be played for students to sing along at the end of the presentation. (p. 41)



### WHAT TO PRINT FROM THE WEB SITE...

The virtual Walk Through the American Revolution requires extra printing of the following:

#### 3. Teacher Use

- Click here for: [Order of Presentation](#) (Teacher use only) This needs to be filled in by the teacher prior to the presentation to aid in spotlighting each student when it is their turn to recite. Note: The Card Assignment List on page 18 of the Teacher Preparation Guide is NOT in order and can be used for assigning parts only – not for spotlighting students.

#### 4. Student Use

Please print and distribute to the three students assigned or provide the link for the students to access directly on our Web site.

The Battle Narration cards take the place of the Battle Scenes that are utilized in the in-person for re-enacting the battles. The Battle Narration cards are the narrated parts of the battle scenes only and are to be assigned to one student on the team for which the narration cards are designated (Lexington/Concord – White Team; Trenton/Valley Forge – Blue Team; Yorktown – Red Team)

### CHECKLISTS...

#### 5. Please ensure students have the following ready to be utilized during the virtual experience:

- Assigned Character, Expert Word, American Experiment and Battle Narration card(s)

Note: Character cards contain “performance instructions” that students will receive points for during the virtual presentation. Some of these include actions. Since students are unable to do the actions, they can still receive points by telling the presenter what they would be doing i.e. I am now going to give the socks I knitted to my husband George Washington.

- Liberty Bell Game Sheet
- Writing utensil
- Dressed in historical attire (for students not assigned a character, they can dress in colonial wear)
- Devices edited to include the students **FIRST NAME** and **TEAM COLOR** i.e. Lori (Blue)

Note: Please do not add character names. We will need student’s first names only and team color. This will be important for awarding points to the correct team. Names can be edited by each student on their zoom screen or by their teacher

#### 6. Teachers will need to be prepared with the following for the virtual experience:



- Ensure students are assigned to three teams using the **Card Assignment List** – p. 18  
All cards pre-designated to the following team colors: **RED, WHITE, BLUE**  
*Please make sure students assigned more than one card are assigned to cards within the same team. A student should be assigned to one team only.*
- The [Order of Presentation](#) filled in PRIOR to your presentation. This will aid you in spotlighting students.
- Score Sheet (p. 21, Teacher Preparation Guide)
- Pencil/writing utensil for recording scores
- You may access certificates on our Web site for printing and distribution.
